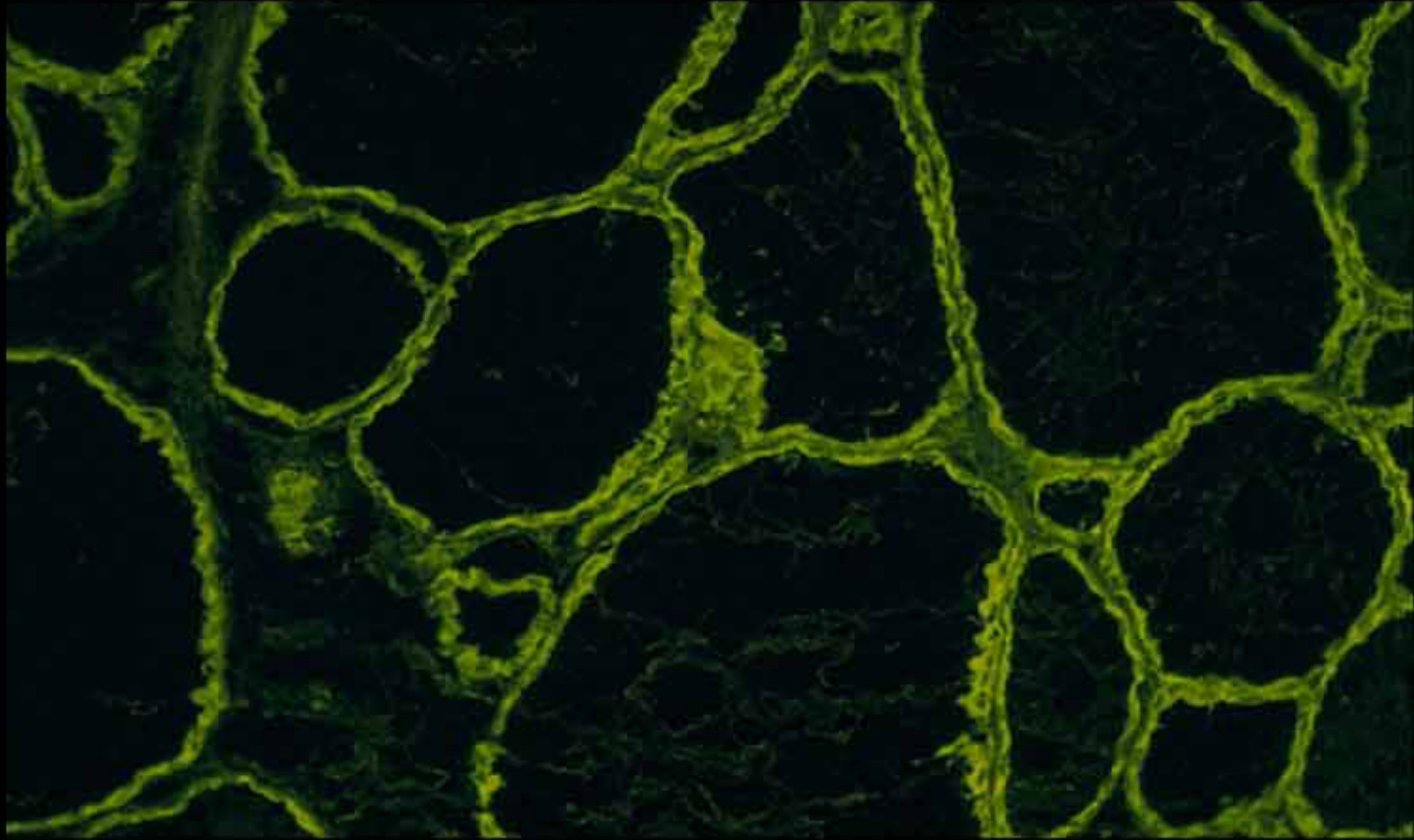


IAN HACKING
